



Fitting instructions

Rear Brake shoe

Rear brake shoe component



S	Name
1	Wheel cylinder
2	Return spring
3	Leading shoe
4	Shoe hold spring
5	adjuster level
6	Trailing shoe
7	Lining
8	Anchor
9	Parking level
10	back plate








Important points

- Clean brake lining with a vacuum dust collector to minimize the hazard of airborne materials.
- Make sure parking brake lever and pedal is completely released.


Removal steps




Step 1: Release parking brake lever and pedal fully, then remove drum.

If drum is hard to remove, the following procedures should be carried out.

a. Remove plug. To make shoe clearance, push shoe hold-down spring to free toggle lever.



b. Install two bolts as shown.Tighten the two bolts gradually



Step 2: After removing retainer;

- Remove spring by rotating shoes.
- Remove adjuster.
- Disconnect parking brake cable from toggle lever

Be careful not to damage wheel cylinder piston boots.

Be careful not to damage parking brake cable when separating it.









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
Step 3: Remove retainer ring with a suitable tool. Then separate toggle lever and brake shoe.

Inspection



Wheel cylinder:

- Check wheel cylinder for leakage.
- Check for wear, damage and loose conditions. Replace if any such condition exists.



Wheel cylinder overhaul:


- Check all internal parts for wear, rust and damage. Replace if necessary.
- Pay attention so as not to scratch cylinder when installing pistons.








Inspection



Drums:


- Contact surface should be fine finished with No. 120 to 150 emery paper.
- Using a drum lathe, resurface brake drum if it shows scoring, partial wear or stepped wear.
- After brake drum has been completely reconditioned or replaced, check drum and shoes for proper contact pattern.
- By using the vernier caliper measure the inner diameter of the drums if the result is out of specification replace it.



Brake lining:

 check the lining thickness of the brake shoe with rule and compare it

Installation



Step 1:

- Fit toggle lever to brake shoe with retainer ring.
- Apply brake grease to the contact areas shown at left.










Installation



Step 2:

- Shorten adjuster by rotating it.
- To tighten loosened brake shoes, first, insert a screwdriver in the direction shown in the left.
- Move the adjuster in the direction shown by the arrow while disengaging the tooth contact.
- Never tap the area E.
- Connect parking brake cable to toggle lever.
- Install all parts.
- Check all parts are installed properly.
- Install brake drum.
- Adjust parking brake
